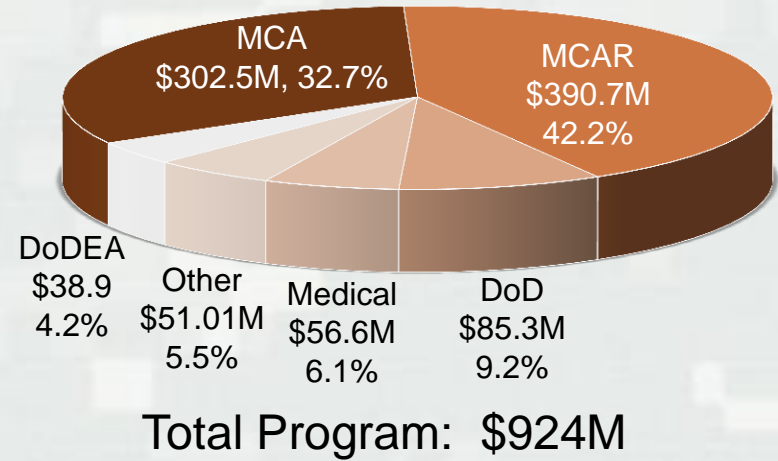

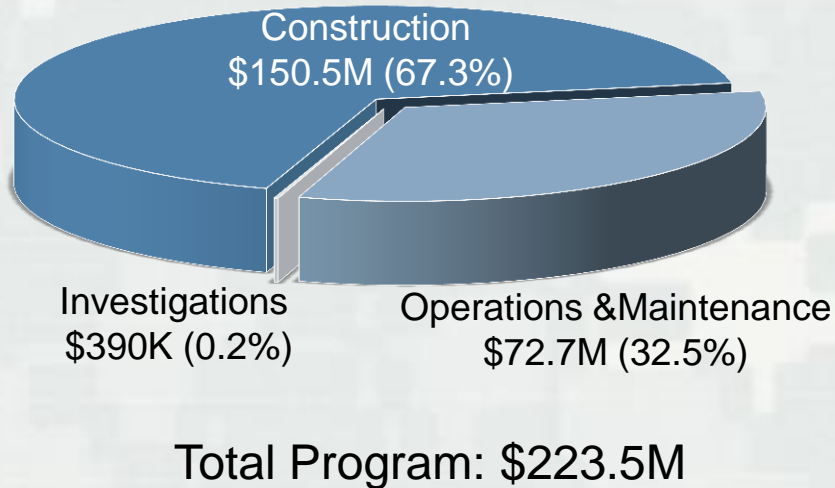
FY 12 Louisville District Programs



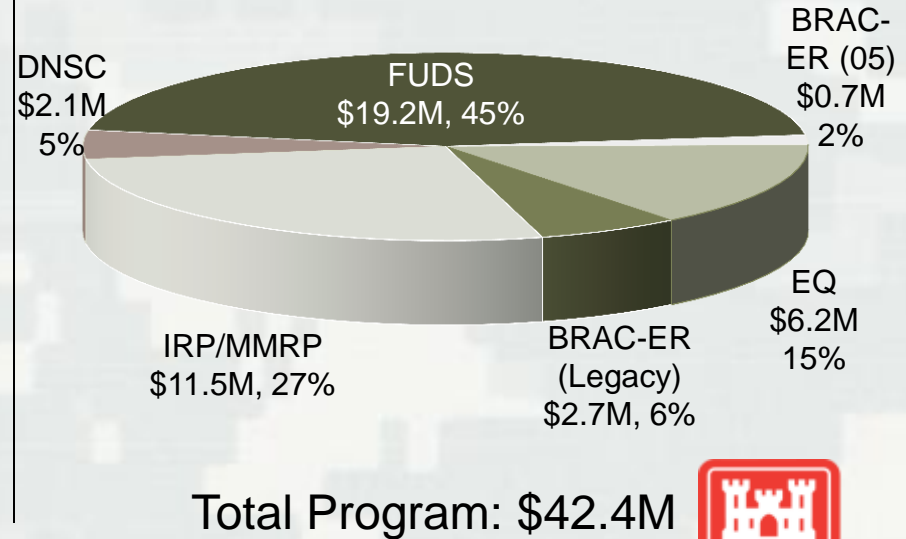
FY 12 Military Program

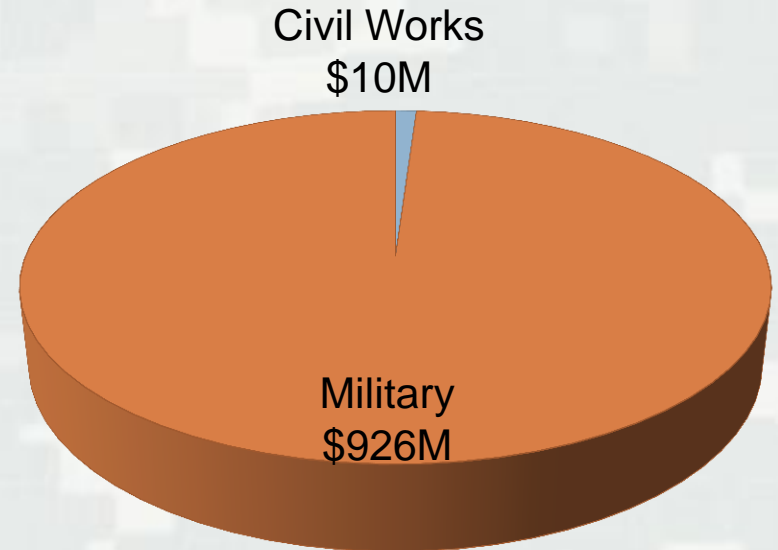
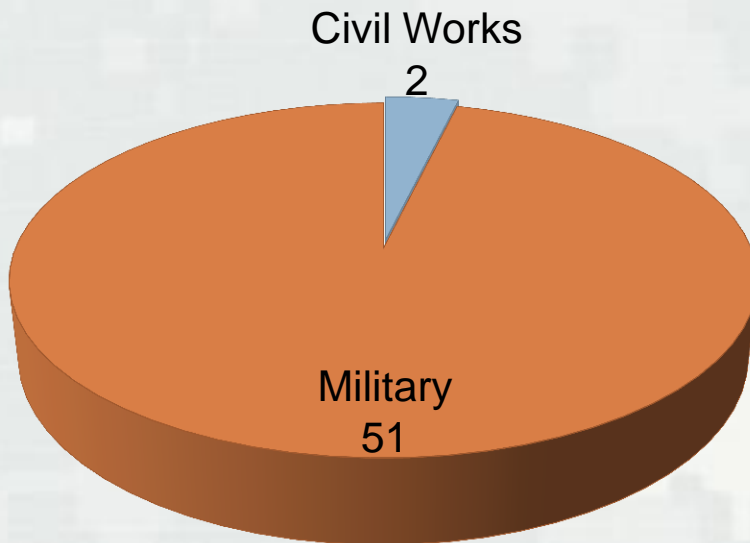

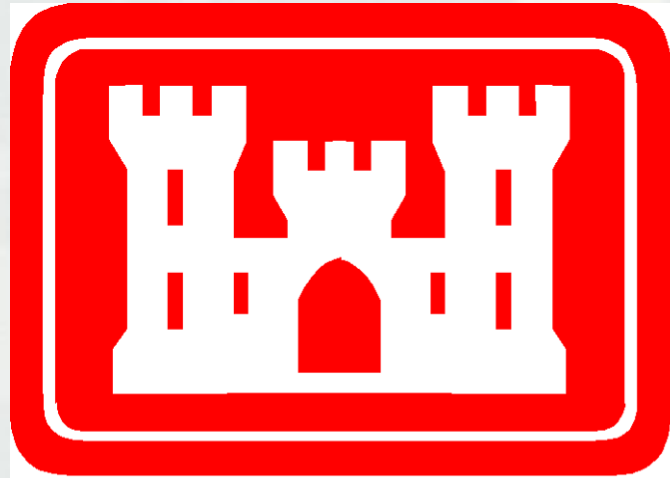
LRL's Impact on the Nation
